2018 OAK HOBBC MEET

- Date:** February 3rd, 2018
- Hosted By:** Oakville Aquatic Club
- Location:** Iroquois Ridge Community Centre, 1151 Glenashton Drive, Oakville, ON
- Facility:** 8-Lane 25 metre pool with Colorado electronic timing
- Meet Package:** The only meet package considered as valid must be the most current version found on www.swimming.ca
- Competition Coordinator:** Carol Frick-Allon – Level 5
- Meet Manager:** Laura Robertson Level 3 meetmanager@oakvilleaquatics.ca
- Competition Rules:** Sanctioned by Swim Ontario.
All current Swimming/Natation Canada (SNC) rules will be followed.
- Please note that Swimming Canada Competition Warm-Up Safety Procedures will be in effect. The full document can be viewed [HERE](#).
- For club and provincial meets, a swimsuit that covers more of the body such as modesty swimwear or religious cover-ups is permitted providing that the fabric is permeable open mesh textile material and does not give the swimmer an advantage. The full interpretation can be viewed [HERE](#). Advanced notification or for clarification of interpretation please see the Competition Coordinator.
- Only participating swimmers, officials, certified registered coaches and authorized people are allowed on deck.
- Eligibility:** All athletes must be registered as Competitive swimmers with SNC, or any other amateur swimming organization recognized by FINA. A valid SNC registration number is required for all Canadian swimmers, and entries without a SNC registration number will be declined entry.
- AGE UP DATE:** Ages submitted are to be as February 3, 2018.
- Qualifying Standards:** There is no qualifying time standard for entry into this meet.^[SEP]
- Entry Deadline:** Entries must be submitted through the SNC online entries system at www.swimming.ca. Entries are closed to Oakville and Brantford.
All entries must be received by **Tuesday, January 30th, 2018**.
Meet Management will not accept entries directly via email.

- Entry Fees:** \$2.00 per swimmer. There is a 4 event limit per swimmer.
Please make cheque payable to **OAKVILLE AQUATIC CLUB**.
- Awards:** Best time ribbons (based on entry times). All NT entries will receive a best time ribbon.
- Meet Notes:** Events will be seeded by age group.
No scratch penalty shall be imposed for late or day of scratches. All scratches need to be received by the Clerk of Course no less than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.
All events are time finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest.
Sessions will run per the Schedule of Events and are separated out by age group.

A coaches meeting will be held on deck by the Awards table at 2:45pm.
- Coach's Registration:** Meet management will cross reference the list of coaches in attendance at this competition with the [Swim Ontario Compliancy lists](#). If a coach is not on this list, meet management is obligated to enforce the SNC policy and not permit that coach to attend meet. Meet management will forward Swim Ontario a list of coaches who they have found to be in non-compliance.
- Mixed Gender:** Mixed gender swims may also be permitted when, due to a missed swim, it is necessary for a referee to seed a swimmer in a heat of the same or shorter distance, for competitors of the opposite gender, on an exception basis.

In spite of this rule, any swimmer who achieves a record time at any level (regional, provincial, national etc, whether age group or open) will not be recognized for that record unless the coach has advised the referee prior to the start of the session that there is a possibility of the record being broken, and the referee insures that the swimmer competes with competitors of the same gender for his/her heat.

In the event that mixed gender swims are permitted pursuant to this policy, the results must still be posted separately by the gender of swimmers.
- Meet Results:** Official Results will be posted within 48 hours of completion of the meet to www.swimming.ca
- Recording Event:** Only individuals that have made application and received authorization to record the event, in any manner, in any medium or context now known or hereafter developed, shall be granted access and permission to do so. Please contact Meet Manager for application and authorization.
